Scope: Providing a forum for student members to engage in information sharing, networking, and input into resources and member benefits offered by AHIMA. Promoting the value of AHIMA credentials, providing guidance and support in the test preparation process, promote student involvement at the CSA level, and collectively finding, creating and sharing career development opportunities.

Qualifications: Must be a NHHIMA member in good standing.

Term of Office: Two-year term

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide input and feedback for projects designed for NHHIMA student members
- Coordinate activities for student member engagement on a local level
- Assist in the effort to publicize the programs aimed at student member engagement
- Attend, and recruit student members to attend, local career fairs and other student recruitment activities for the profession
- Develop a relationship with CAHIIM-accredited programs in the NHHIMA to encourage student membership
- Identify local networking and volunteer opportunities for student members
- Work with NHHIMA leaders to identify HIM speakers to present at CAHIIM accredited programs to speak & engage with students about the HIM Profession, AHIMA, and the value of credentials.
- Promote early certification testing to student members and help CSA identify reasons for delays in testing.
- Participate on AHIMA's Engage Online Communities
- Communicate ideas and progress on initiatives to the AHIMA Student Advisory Council

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
